29	Doi Begun (Aubergine)	<i>Fried Aubergine cooked in a yogurt gravy and finished with traditional spices</i>	£5.95
30	Dimer (Egg) Dalna	<i>Traditional Egg curry cooked in a Bengali style</i>	£6.95
